Uniform

Millbrook has a distinctive school uniform of purple, grey and gold. Visitors to the school frequently comment on how smart our children look. We believe that the uniform helps children develop a sense of pride in their appearance and their school, as well as contributing to setting a disciplined and studious atmosphere. All children are expected to wear school uniform and we have adopted the following options (which have been drawn up in accordance with Buckinghamshire County Council's Minority Ethnic and Traveller Achievement Service guidance):

Key Stage 1 & 2 (infants and juniors):

Boys: Purple sweatshirt, grey trousers, white shirt, school tie, white or black socks and sensible black shoes. In hot weather the white shirt may be replaced with a short-sleeved shirt and tailored shorts.

Girls: Purple cardigan or sweatshirt, grey tunic or skirt, white blouse or shirt, white or black socks or tights or white salwar or grey trousers, school tie (optional), sensible black shoes. In hot weather, the grey tunic may be replaced with a Lilac gingham dress and the white blouse or shirt replaced with a short-sleeved white shirt.

Boys & Girls: Peaked cap with school logo

Uniform may be purchased from the school office, each Tuesday morning between 8:30 and 9:15 a.m. or Thursday afternoon between 3:00pm and 3:45pm.

Please would parents and children note that jeans or trainers are not part of our school uniform.

CLOTHING FOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION (PE), GAMES and SWIMMING

All children are expected to change into clothing appropriate for PE.

Boys: Black plimsolls for indoor PE and black trainers for outdoor games, black shorts, house colour T-shirt, black or grey tracksuit. Swimwear, towel and a house colour swimming hat

Girls: Black plimsolls for indoor PE and black trainers for outdoor games, black shorts or leggings, house colour T-shirt, black or grey tracksuit. Swimwear, towel and house colour swimming hat.
