

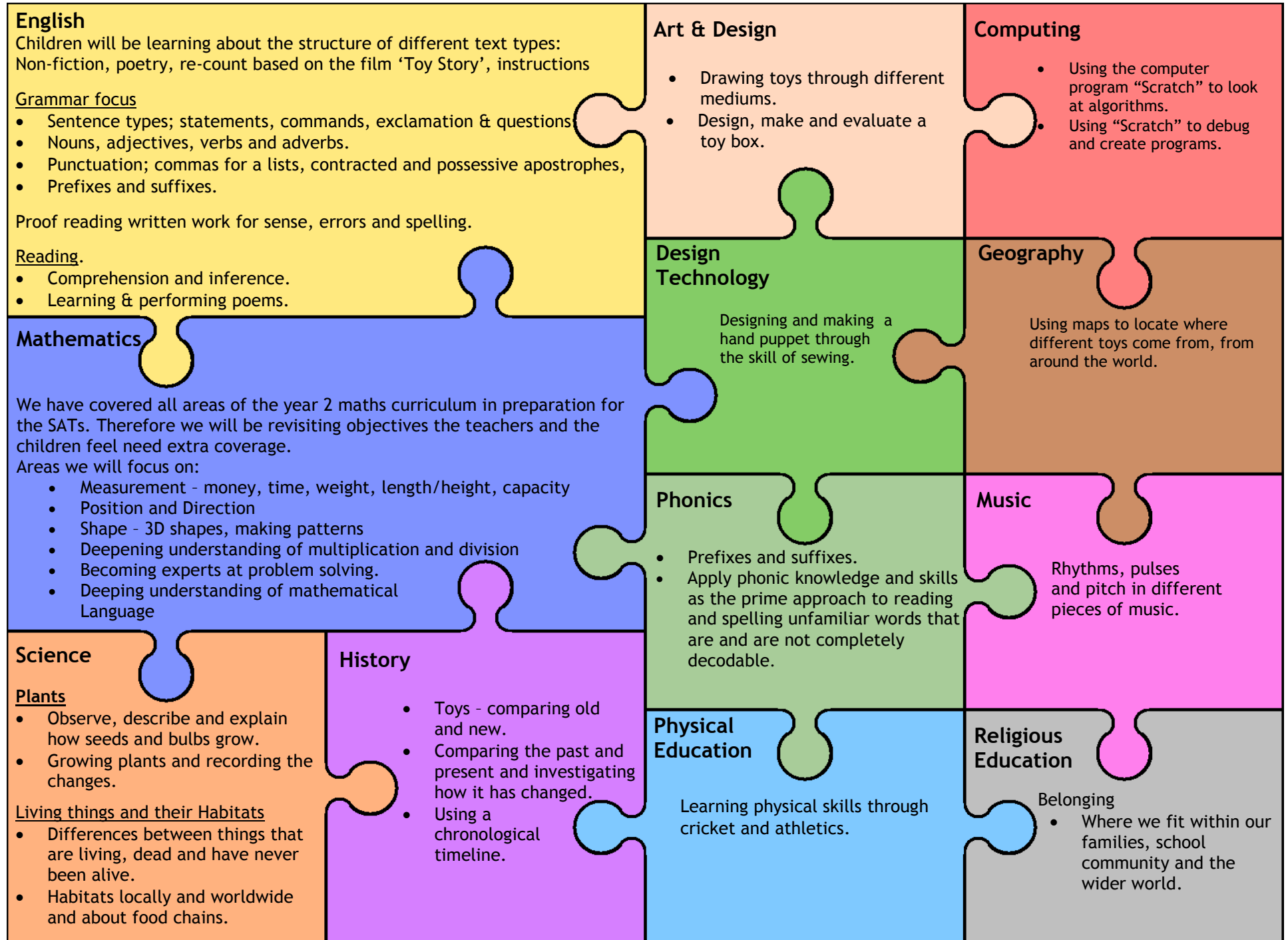

Tips for Learning

Please read with your child every day and sign their reading diaries. They earn reading miles for each day that is read and achieve certificates for every 25.

Make maths real and talk about numbers, let your child work out simple costs when using money, look for shapes in the environment. Play games, cards, board games and interactive games on the internet, www.topmarks.co.uk and www.mathletics.com - all children have their personal logins.

Learning Log Activity - Every week your child is given a learning log activity which can be interpreted in different ways (in writing, creatively, or by using different resources). Please support your child to engage with this task.

Practise the spellings with your child every day. Remember your child needs to write a sentence for each spelling word to show their understanding of word meanings.

DBPrimary - Is a learning platform we use a Millbrook. Every child has their personal login and can play games to further their learning. <https://millbrook-bucks.secure-dbprimary.com>

All children in year two are required to undertake Standardised Assessment Testing, (SATs) in May. Please try and ensure that your child is in school in preparation for this.

Any child who did not reach the required level in the phonics screening check in year one will be completing again in June. The phonics screening check is designed to confirm whether pupils have learnt phonic decoding to an appropriate standard. It will identify pupils who need extra help to improve their decoding skills.
