



Tips for Learning

Please read with your child every day and sign their reading diaries. They earn reading miles for each day that is read and achieve certificates for every 25.

Make maths real and learn your timetables as children need to know their multiplication facts and be able to recall these quickly. Maths website to use are:

www.topmarks.co.uk and www.mathletics.com - all children have their personal logins.

Learning Log Activity - Every week your child is given a learning log activity which can be interpreted in different ways (in writing, creatively, or by using different resources). Please support your child to engage with this task. They will also receive maths and English homework.

Practise the spellings with your child every day. Remember your child needs to write a sentence for each spelling word to show their understanding of word meanings.
